How To Check Your Out-Of-Network Coverage And Possible Out-Of-Network Benefits

- Plan for 15-30 minutes of your time available to call your insurance company
- Make sure to have this information ready before your call: Pen and paper/notepad, insurance card, name, date of birth, address, phone number, or possibly social security number of the cardholder or person for whom the services are for, and a.
- Questions to ask:
 - Are there out-of-network benefits for this policy?
 - o Do I have a mental or behavioral health policy with out-of-network benefits?
 - o What are the requirements to use out-of-network benefits?
 - o Is prior authorization required?
 - o Is a referral required from my primary care physician?
 - o Do I have an out-of-network deductible? If yes, what is my out-of-network deductible?
 - o How much of my out-of-network deductible has been met?
 - o What is the start date of the calendar year my out-of-network policy is based on?
 - o In addition, ask the representative if your policy covers these services (use the CPT codes provided below).
 - o How much is the insurance company's "usual and customary fee" and what percentage do they cover?
 - o Is there a session limit? If yes, what is the session limit? How many sessions do I have left?
 - What percentage of services is covered/what is my co-insurance?
- At the end of the call, make sure to have:
 - o Date/time you called
 - o Representative's name
 - o Reference number for the call
 - o Information that will be provided on your requested receipt of payment:
 - o Provider's name
 - o Provider's NPI
 - o Provider's license number
 - o Federal Tax ID number
 - o DSM-5 and ICD-10 diagnosis codes
 - o CPT or Procedure codes

Here is a listing of common CPT codes. Not all of these codes will be used, but please ask about each code specifically to ensure your understanding of benefits.
